According to the Oklahoma Tourism & Recreation Department 2021 Economic Impact Report, the travel industry generated \$81.1 million dollars in state tax revenue in 2021, supporting more than 11,000 jobs in south-central Oklahoma.²

In honor of National Travel and Tourism Week, Chickasaw Country is honoring the indispensable contributions of travel through a series of videos that spotlight the unsung heroes of the industry. From park rangers and casino staff to travel stop workers and masterful brewers in the region, each employee featured in this project is a crucial cog in the wheel of
